Markku Markkula is a former member of the Finnish Parliament (1995-2003) with influential positions in international committees promoting lifelong learning, innovation and knowledge management. As an MP his international role included the Presidency of EPTA Council, European Parliamentary Technology Assessment Network. Currently he is Team Leader responsible for activities focusing on the economic, social and cultural impacts of the new Aalto University (www.aalto.fi). He is on leave of absence from his position as the Director of the Lifelong Learning Institute Dipoli of Helsinki University of Technology (TKK).

He is the Chairman of the European Society of Engineering Education (SEFI CEE) Working Group and the Chairman of the Board of Directors of EuroPACE. In addition he is the Chairman of the Board of the Finnish Information Society Development Centre TIEKE.

In 2008, as a tribute to his achievements Markku Markkula was elected to the International Adult and Continuing Education Hall of Fame.
